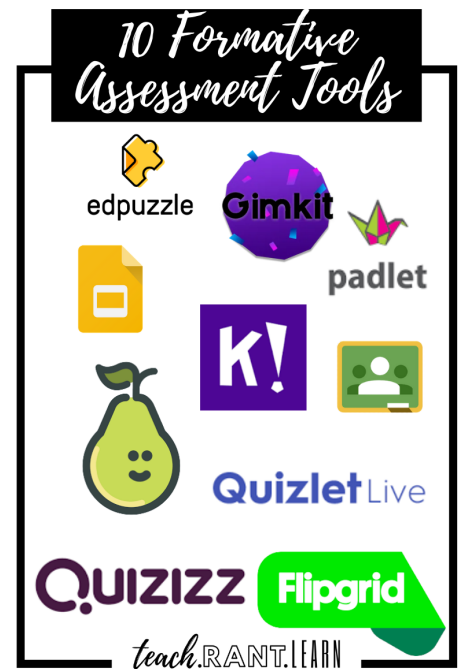


Online Classes
