ENTITY CLUB WORKSHOP ON FIRST AID (VI) REPORT

It is beyond doubt that knowledge of first aid promotes a safer and healthier environment. Having students who are well equipped with first aid skills contribute to enhancing the safety of the school. Many students experience accidents while they are at school or any other place. The accidents might lead to simple injuries, serious wounds or fractures. However, the victim can be given initial assistance until the doctor arrives. It is important to have trained and informed students who can utilise their skills and take quick action to treat the affected person. They can apply the right procedures to prevent more damage. Sensitizing the students for the same, MBS International School, Sector 11, Dwarka organised a workshop on "First Aid" for the students of grade VI on October 28, 2020. The workshop imparted knowledge of commonly occurring accidents in our day to day life. It was explained to the students as to how one should remain calm and give basic medical aid to people in need. The students were taught the importance of 'First Aid' in different situations. In the case of burns, electric shocks, dislocations, dog bites etc. and what kind of First Aid we should give to save the person from the worsening condition.

The aim of the workshop could be summarized in three key points:

- 1. Preserve life-Save life and minimize damage
- 2. Prevent further harm
- 3. Promote recovery

The workshop was helpful in dealing with common accidents and equipped the students to deal with the same.
