Name of the Activity: Shakespeare Character Dramatisation

Objectives:

- To build self-confidence among the learners.
- To lead the speakers to speak for more than a minute on the given task.
- To encourage the learners to work in learner-friendly atmosphere.
- To increase the learners' autonomy so that they can prepare their own speeches.

Lingua Franca Week activity namely, 'Shakespeare Character Dramatization' was conducted on July 24, 2019 for the students of class IX.
