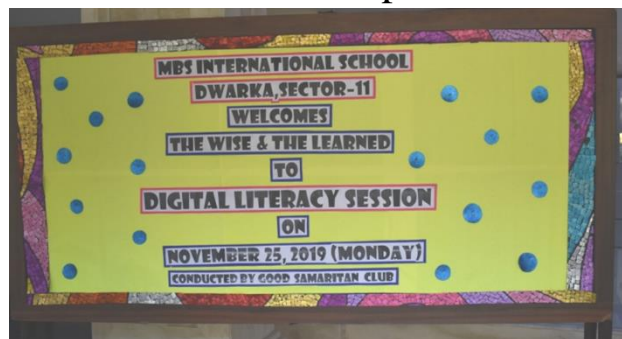
TOPIC: DIGITAL LITERACY SESSION FOR SENIOR CITIZENS
