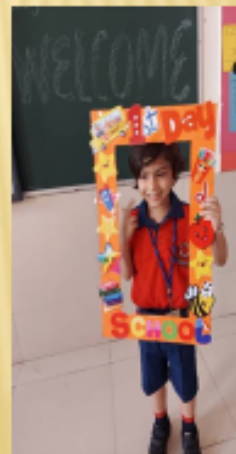
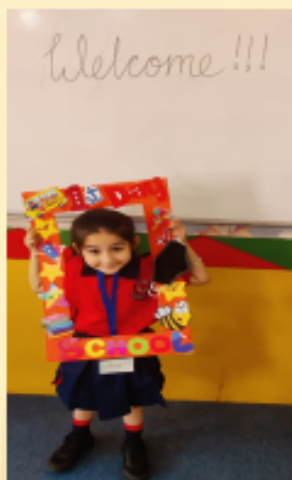
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welcome Back to school

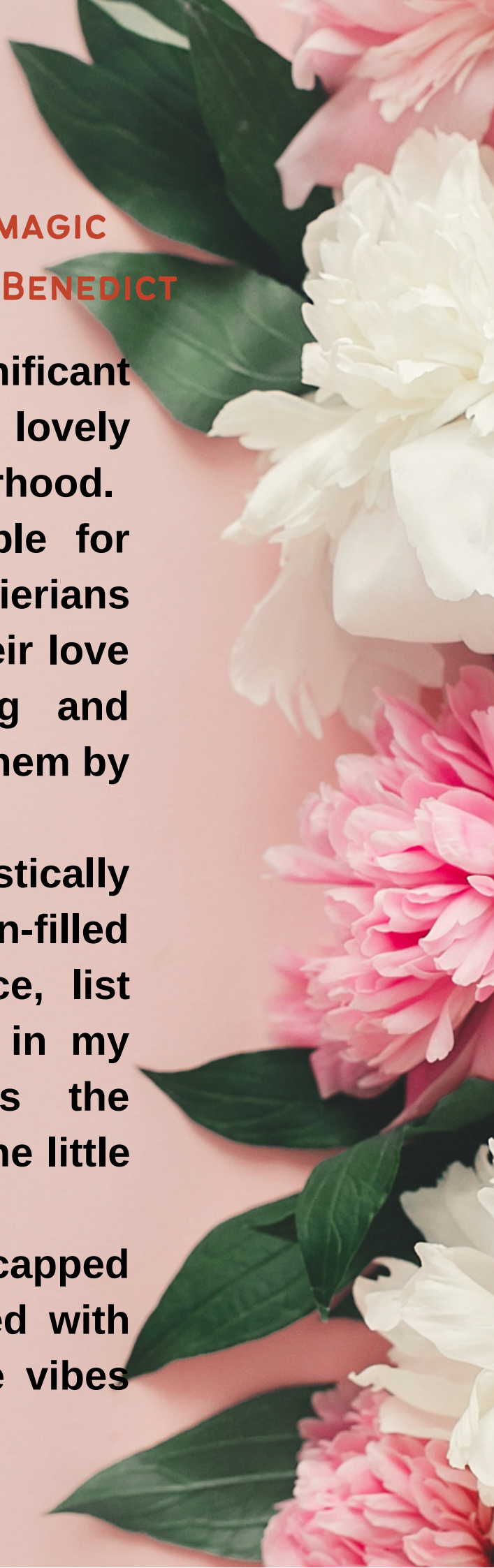


**TO A CHILD'S EAR, 'MOTHER' IS MAGIC


Summer means Happy times and good times !

Sensory activities encourage young minds to observe, explore and investigate, that stimulates children's senses, which are the different ways we perceive the world.







Sensory play in early childhood plays an important role in brain development because sensory stimulation is essential for sensory integration and cognitive development.

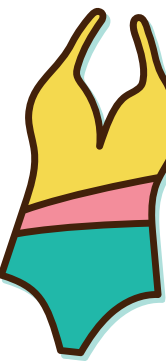
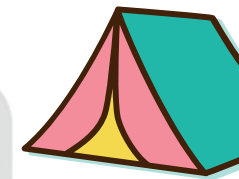
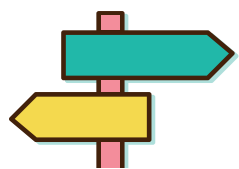
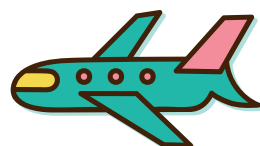
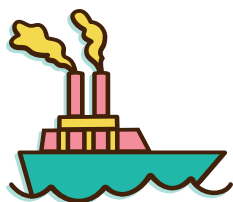
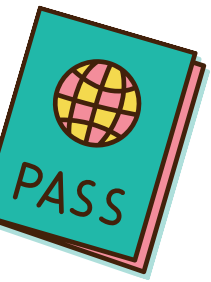
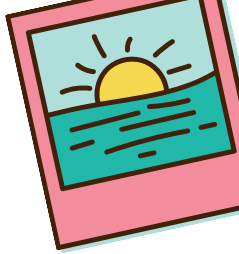
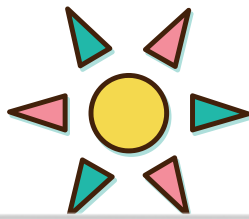

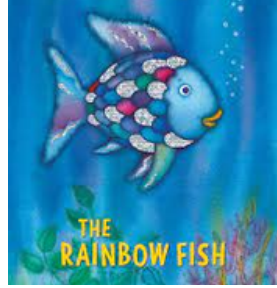
“Love the Earth as you would love yourself”

ourselves from within"*

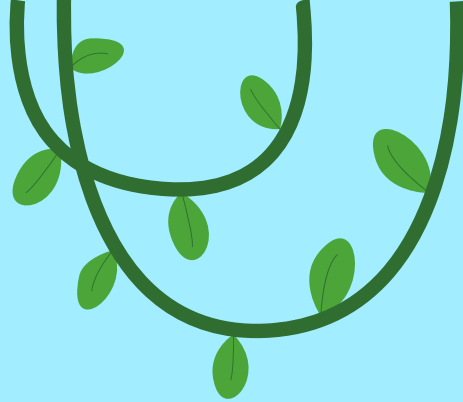

The innumerable benefits of practicing yoga and meditation were also elucidated to all the participants.





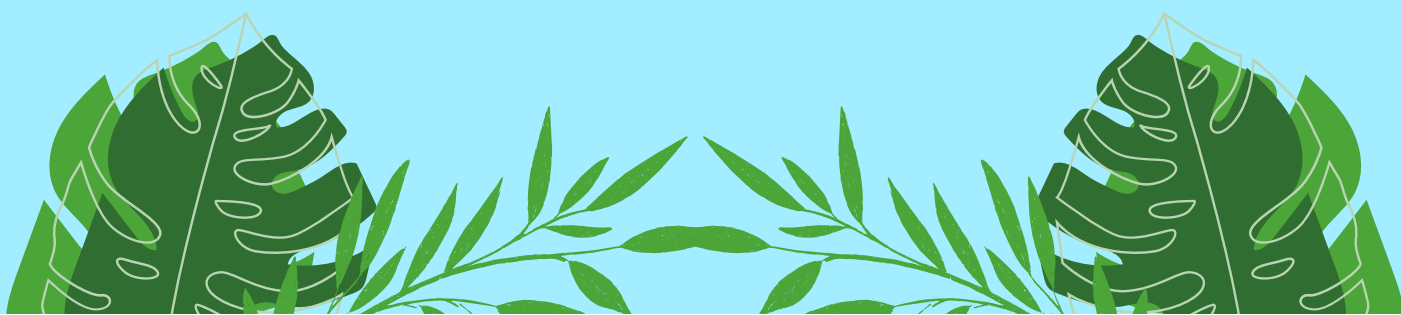


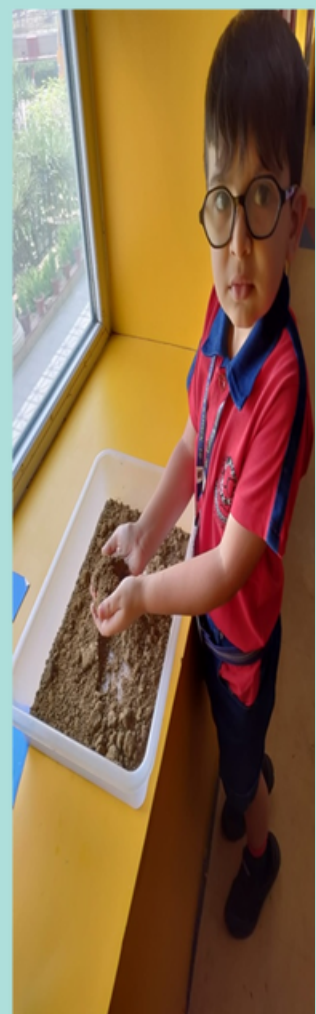

SUBJECT ENRICHMENT

Keeping in view all these factors various subject enrichment activities were planned for our Kindergarten explorers.

In Hindi, for teaching formation of vyanjans in interesting ways , suji lekhan and clay moulding were used.

In English, methods such as rainbow writing, air and sand tracing were used to practise small cursive letters.

In Math, Black gram activity for quantification and flash cards were used to recapitulate numbers.

EVS is an enjoyable and interesting theme-based learning. Learners were introduced to the topics Myself, My Family, My senses through various modules, experiments and group activities. All the activities helped the learners to grasp the topic well and that too in a playful manner.
