
#### SAVE WATER

The day was filled with oodles of blessings, happy faces, excitement, and cheer.



STEAM for young encourages active hands-on experiences, which building supports, understanding and vocabulary, critical thinking, problem-solving, communication, and reflection. Blocks have been a staple childhood activity for decades, young minds can learn a variety of gain a more comprehensive and understanding of the concepts they are learning in class by playing with blocks, they learn about balance, stability, and spatial thinking, through experimenting with stacking knocking over blocks.

Keeping this in view during the month of July our young learners were introduced to STEAM, where a variety of topics were taken, to help them learn and create with the help of blocks example, Pineapple, cactus, watermelon, plants, etc.













Xavenium an inter- school Fest-E-Fiesta has been a tradition at St. Xavier's High school ,Sec -49 since 2018-2019.It's a two day event and is organized for classes Pre Nursery to Grade 5.This year the theme was 'Salvage: Awakening Young Minds.' It included wildlife ,marine life ,water, sustainable energy and eco enrichment to challenge the young minds. Dance, drama, declamation ,music ,poem ,art & craft and quizzes were some of the competitions designed in the most innovative ways.







#### SUBJECT ENRICHMENT

Enrichment activities are fun. It helps students engage better in their learning and gives them a platform to explore.

Our school leaves no stone unturned; we organize different innovative activities to make learning more prominent. Our Kindergarten explorers engaged themselves in numerous activities as mentioned below.

In Hindi, learners decorated 'th se thela' and enjoyed making the formations of introduced vyanjans using playdough. In English, interesting methods like using different coloured ribbons were used for learning CVC words. With the help of Flashcards, learners enjoyed the Sight word sorting activity. In Math, the Concept of Greater and lesser was introduced through the Hungry crocodile story. 3D shape CUBOID along with the making of the First Aid box was shown to the learners. EVS is an enjoyable and interesting theme-based learning. Learners were introduced to the topics - Water, Community Helpers, and Plants through various modules, experiments, and group activities. During the theme WATER, learners were involved in a Water rally to spread awareness about saving water and participated enthusiastically in group discussions. They also made parts of the plants using colourful clay and also experienced live germination of seeds in the class.
