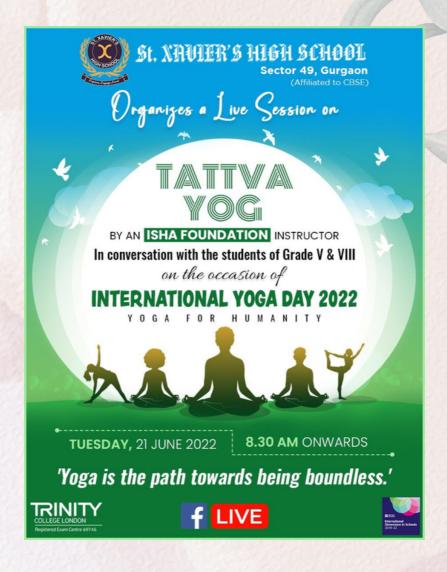












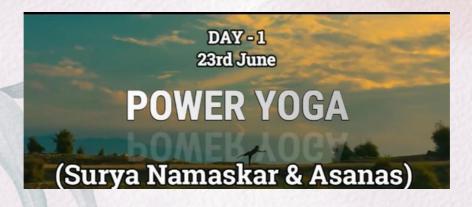

"Mothers are not the ones that never struggle, they are the ones that never give up despite the struggle.

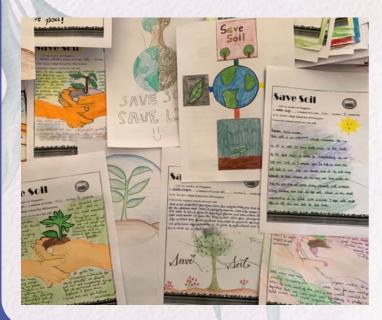
"A mother is your first friend, your best friend, your forever friend."

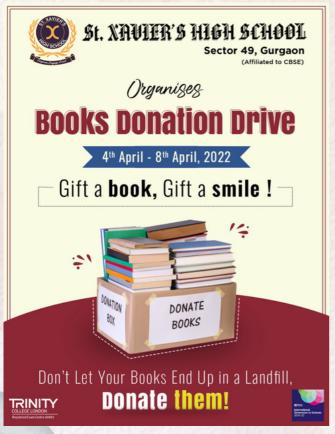

It was indeed a proud moment to witness the little Xaverians read out books patiently to the children who were just the same age as them.

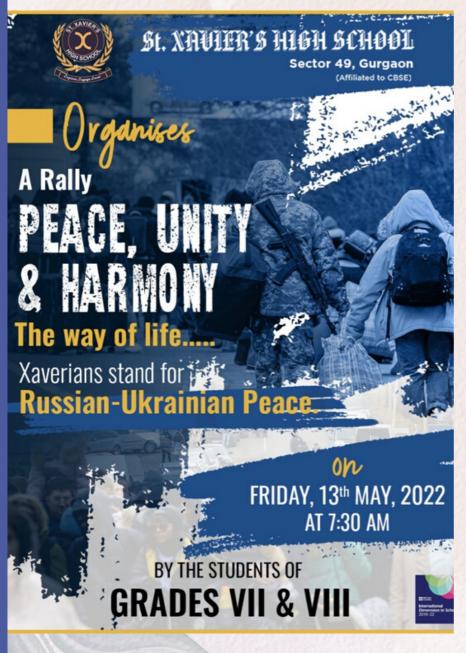
