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

Vaccinations- If you were unable to book your slots for getting yourself vaccinated, we could do the same for you.



1. Oxygen supports burning and the candle goes out as soon as the oxygen supply is cut off.

2. Air exerts pressure (air pressure) which makes it possible for the water level to rise as the candle goes out.

Certainly, experimenting classes were thoroughly enjoyed by all our young scientists.


### EUPHONY-THE BARD'S FEST


### EUPHONY - THE BARD'S FEST DAY 4


#### MOMENTS OF CALM: MEDITATION SESSION




