








At St. Xavier's High School, we always aim at raising responsible and compassionate individuals. We tried to set an example by extending a helping hand to reach out to the less fortunate.

On the occasion of *World Food Day* the school organised Food Donation Drive this year too.


DIWALI CELEBRATION ECO-FRIENDLY DIWALI

SCIENCE AND ILLUSION MUSEUM EXCURSION

Xaverians of Grades VI to VIII went on an exploration spree as part of the Science Excursion on 22nd December 2022. Our curious scholars were awestruck after entering the fascinating world of illusions which was filled with visual, sensory and mind-boggling experiences for the explorers. Be it the Building Illusion, Swap Noses, Colour Room, Rotated Room, Infinity Well, Hollow Face Illusion, Kaleidoscope, Clone Table, Holograms or the Beuchet Chair filled the young minds with wonder and amazement. Each exhibit had some surprising element to ignite inquisitiveness among the students. Walking through the Vortex Tunnel made the students scream with excitement as they stepped forward through a rotating cylinder on a flat and stable surface. The feeling that the room is going topsy-turvy is just an illusion smartly created to trick the excursionists! The students carefully studied the scientific reasoning displayed with each exhibit to understand the concept involved. The next halt in their journey of practical learning was at the National Science Centre, New Delhi where they explored 'Water: The Elixir of Life Gallery' which elaborates well-researched information on water stress in India, adverse effects of acid rain on the ecosystem, water education and water content in the human body. The Science & Technology Heritage Gallery displayed the early mathematical foundations in India, the Harrapan technologies, mining and metallurgy, perfumery processes, metal artefacts, medicine, surgery, art & architecture of ancient India, glasswork, coin making, traditional crafts and textiles. The other attractions included the amazing energy ball, the wonderful human biology gallery, the fun science gallery, the information revolution gallery and Sardar Patel Gallery featuring his unwavering efforts in uniting India. With so much to retain, reflect and research our young scientists went home with a treasure of knowledge and fun-filled memories of an eventful outing.
