

#### **ORIENTATION**



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
## MINDING OUR MINDS

Indeed, The Bard's Fest was an amazing platform to bring all our young Xaverians closer to the magic of the English language and literature.




Open House with the famous author Mr. Vikarn Chowdhary (Day-6) 24.04.2021


#### **CURTAIN RAISER - XAVROLOGUE**











### TATTVA YOG 16 June, 2021

## XMANTRAG-YOGA FOR LIFE (17 JUNE, 2021) DIGITAL PPT MAKING INTER CLASS COMPETITION —



#### Interschool Competition-'Musical Earth Saviours'




