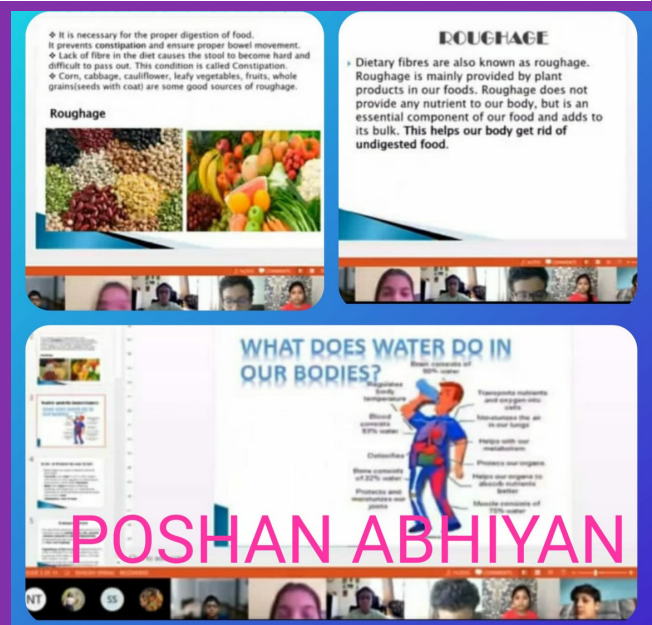


# Inter-Class Hindi Quiz Competition

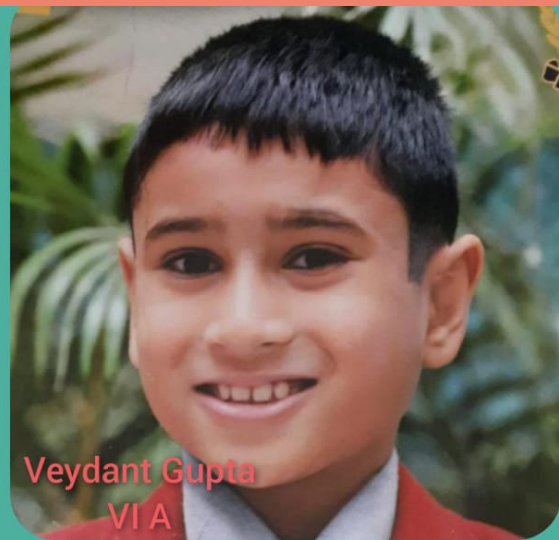

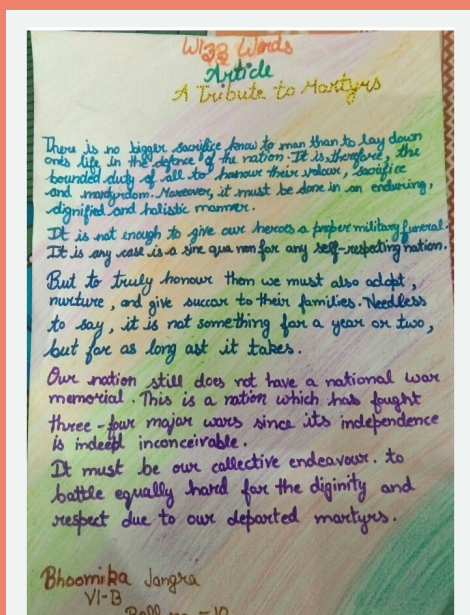
# Inter Class Article Writing Competition- WHIZZ WORDS

"I can shake off everything as I write; my sorrows disappear, my courage is reborn."

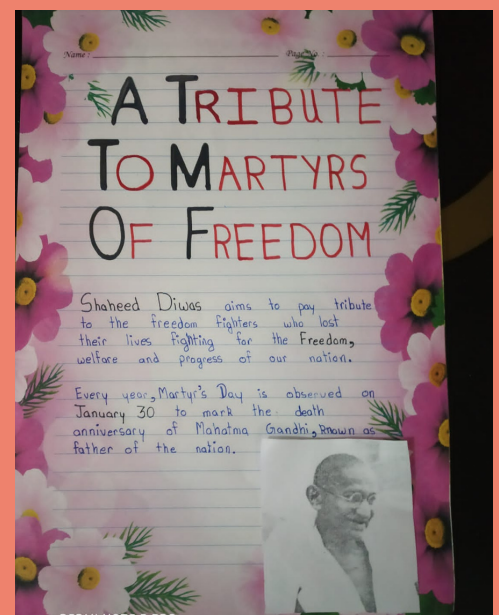
