
Dussehra Celebration


Xaverian Podtale Season 2, Podtale - 18

As part of the celebrations, Siddhi Gupta of Grade 2B of St Xavier's High School spoke about the great leader on Xaverian Podtale -18.






Aaradhana Dutt of Grade 2–C took part in the pod tale with great enthusiasm on the Topic : Why Pluto is no more a Planet?

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









