




Minding our Minds COUNSELLING SESSION

Gallantry Awards are given to boosyst officers, civilians, and forces for acts of bravery and sacrifice. The government of India established gallantry awards to acknowledge acts of bravery and sacrifice by officers and personnel of the armed forces, other lawfully constituted forces, and civilians. These country awards are given out twice a year, once on the occasion of Republic Day and once on the occasion of Independence Day.

Neerja Bhanct is an excellent demonstration of someone who devoted her life to something greater than herself; she risked her life to save the lives of others. She showed courage even in the toughest of the time and was kind to everyone.

Bhanot's fearlessness on Paradigm Flight 73 defined her as a virtuous figure because she died saving the lives of hundreds of people including the American and Pakistani one. She inspired generations of Indian citizens especially me to be courageous when faced with a dilemma and to be compassionate with all people, including strangers.

Even though she was killed that day, her legacy will not be forgotten. For Bhanck's acts of compassion she received the Ashok chakra award, an award given to India's most bopsusable people. Bhanck was given this award for her fearlessness and kindness on the flight. Bhanck's act of compassion influences the people of India to be kind to everyone. Despite the fact that she was killed on that hearthreaking day, her legacy will not be forgotten. She is a role model for young people everywhere, and I want to be just like her and help as many people as possible without judging them as American, British, Pakistani or on any discriminating them in any grounds.
