29th Oct'21: A bowl of water for our favourite fauna

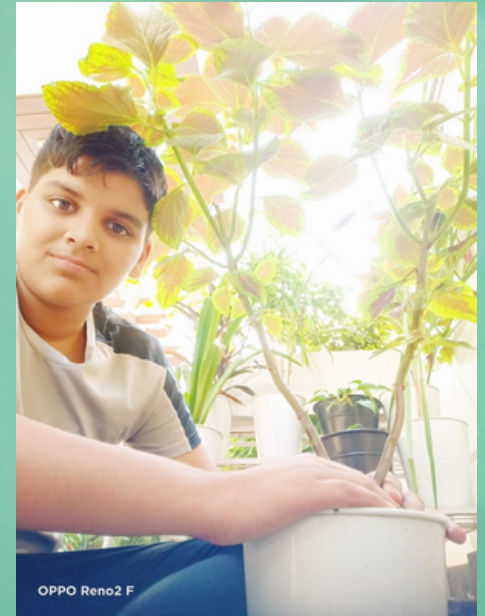

To celebrate the day of innocence and joy, An extravagant Children's Day was celebrated named: BACHPAN for our unique Xaverians.

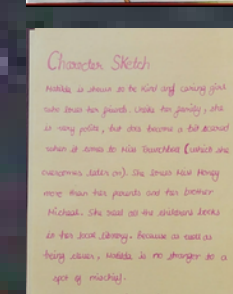
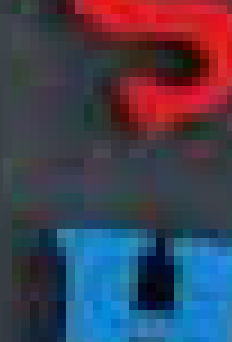
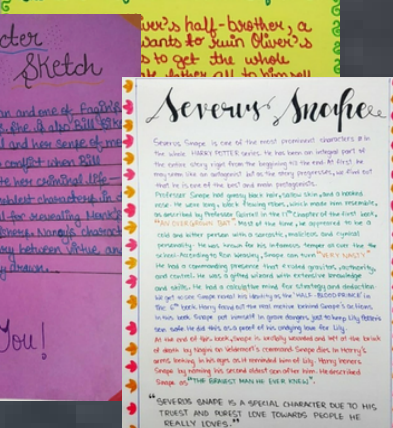
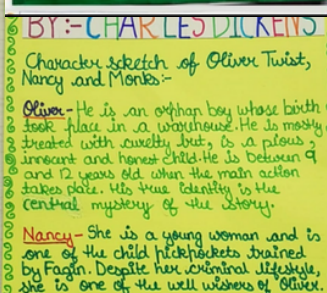
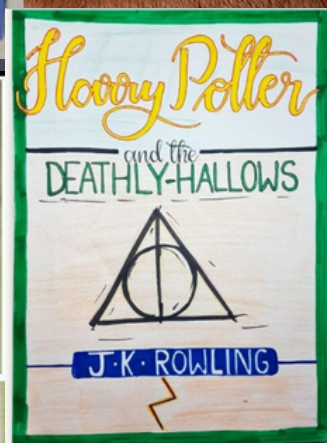
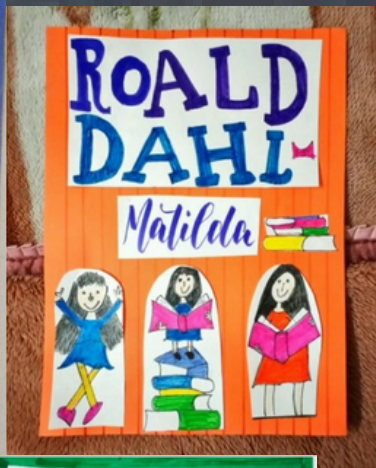
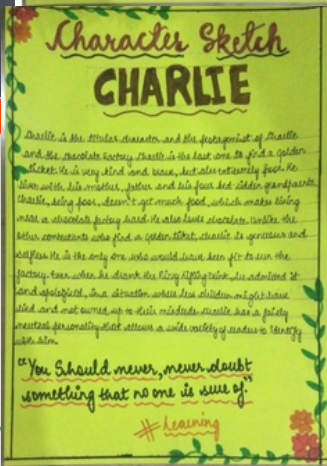
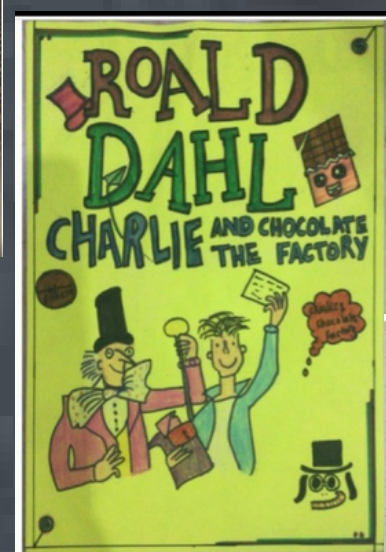
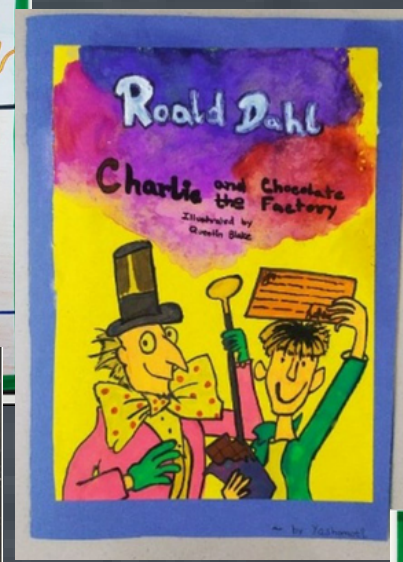
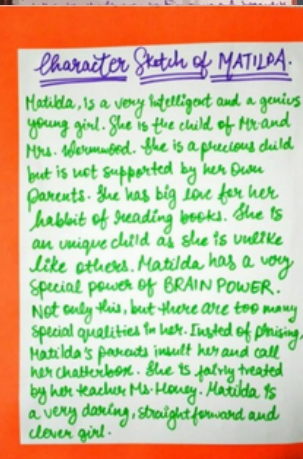
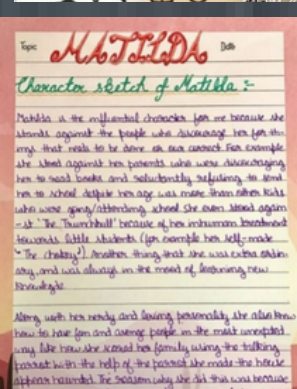
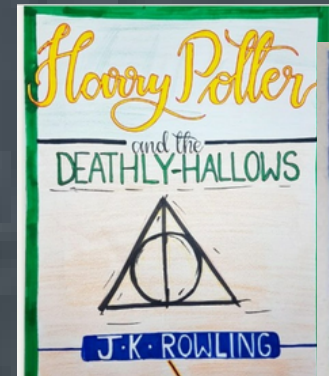

We are extremely ecstatic to share that Shivani is the only student from Gurgaon and one out of the two from Haryana who has won at the National Level.

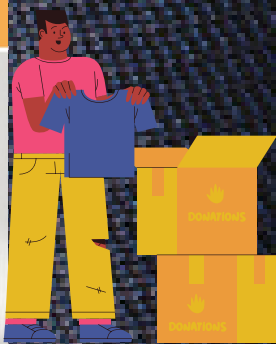
