Remembering Babasaheb Ambedkar, an apostle of great virtues, the chief architect of the Indian Constitution!



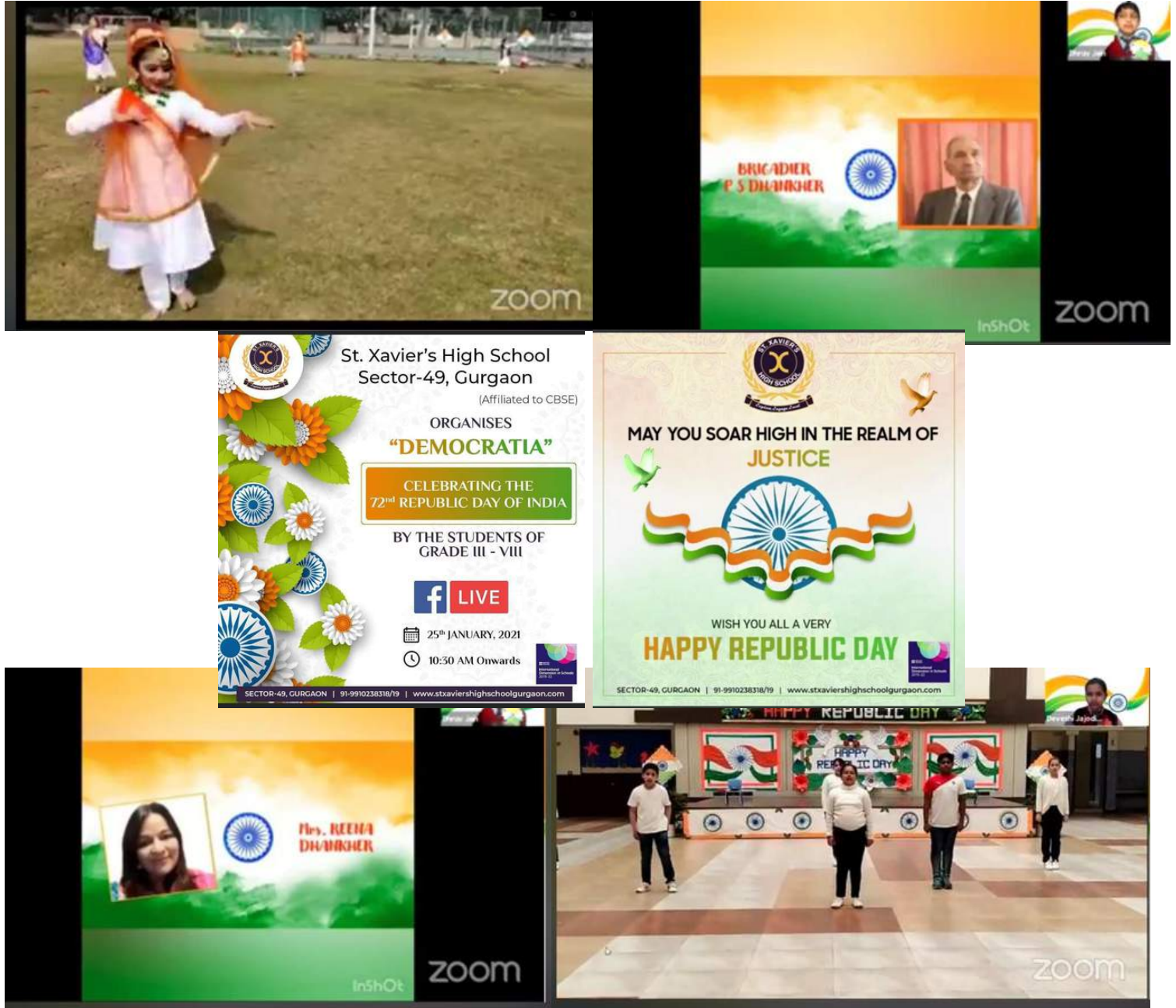

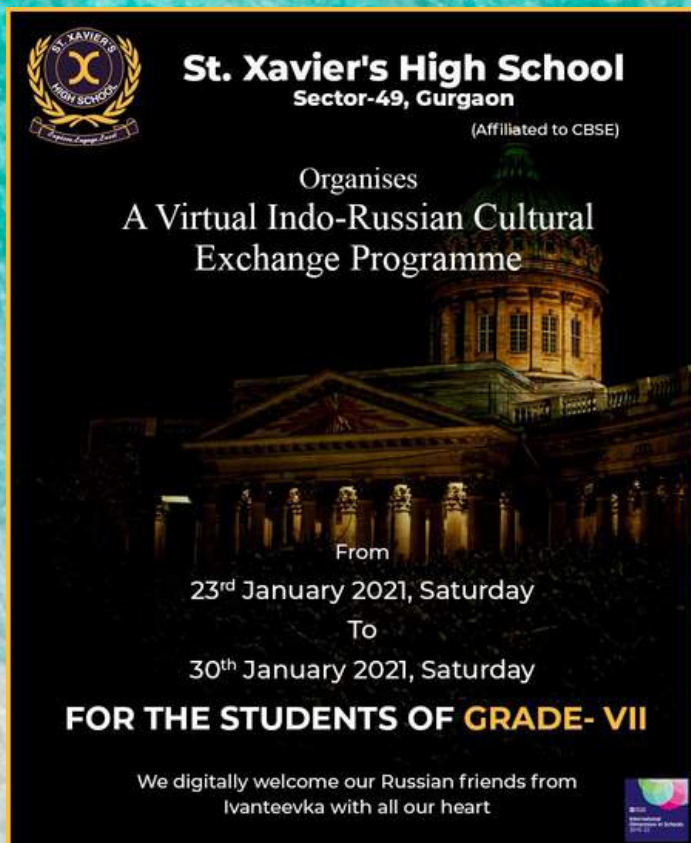

“Cross-Culture meeting is about experiencing a foreign country – and the most beautiful, important part of a country’s culture is its people.”

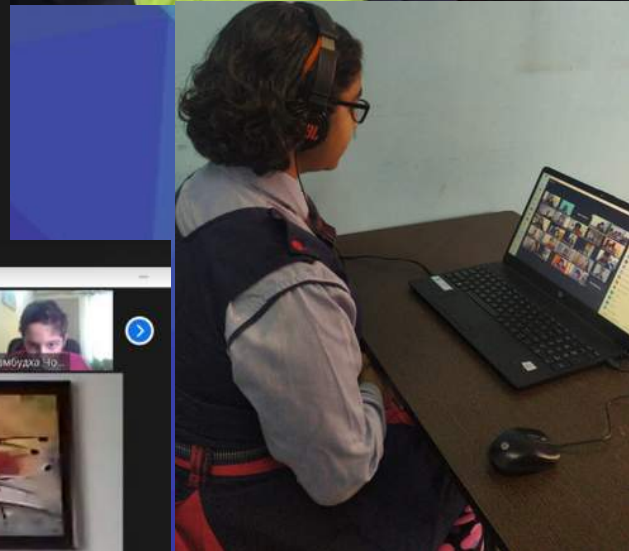
