





STORY SESSION- "The Rose Plant"


(through puppet show, activity and dramatization by students)

We don't argue, we don't fuss






Good Manners aren't too hard to learn,

For Parents


• Take the child for Nature walk and show her different types of leaves, flowers, insects and worms that are found in the garden / plant area.
