- From 05/03/2019 to 20/03/2019 the school timings will be 7:50 am to 11.45 a.m.

Eligibility for Compartment in Secondary Examination (as per CBSE Examination Bye-Laws 41.2)

1. Candidate offering 5 subjects

For candidate offering 5 subjects and failing in 2 of the 5 subjects of external examination shall be placed in compartment in those subjects provided he/she qualifies in all the subjects of internal assessment

- 2. Candidate offering additional NSQF Vocational subject(Marketing & Sales)
 - (a) A Candidate failing in 2 of the 6 subjects of external examination shall be placed in compartment in those subjects provided he/she qualifies in all the subjects of internal assessment.
 - (b) For a candidate who has offered a vocational subject as 6th subject and fails in any of the three compulsory subjects i.e. Science Mathematics and Social Science, the vocational subject (Marketing and Sales offered as 6th additional subject) will replace one of the subjects and the result of class IX Examination will be computed accordingly
