




The Spotlight


It was great opportunity for all budding and aspirant writers to put forth their doubts and learn the nuances of writing.





INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION






Freedom in the mind, faith in the words, pride in our soul, Let's salute the nation on this auspicious day.


COLLECTION DRIVE FOR THE TIRANGA










MINDING OUR MINDS




"Mental strength is not the ability to stay out of darkness, it's the ability to sit in the darkness knowing that the light will shine again."


