The new session will commence on Tuesday, April 2, 2024, with an interaction with your ward's new class teacher to discuss their hobbies, interests, and other pertinent details. Additionally, report cards from the previous session would also be handed over on the same day.

SVIS Students' Council will also organise a Book Donation Drive on April 2, 2024 during the PTM. Parents are requested to actively participate in this social endeavour by donating age appropriate books meant for school students. Please label the books grade-wise, genre-wise fiction/ non-fiction, etc., and deposit them near the Assembly Stage area in the accounts foyer. SVIS students can also pick 1/2 books for free.

Regular classes will begin on Wednesday, April 3, 2024 for Grades PS-X and XII.

Acclimatization Days for Pre-School will be April 3 & 4, 2024 (Wednesday & Thursday). School timing for Pre-School on these days will be 9:00 am -11:00 am. Pre Primary will have off days on Wednesday, April 3, and Thursday, April 4, 2024.

For Grade XI, classes will begin on Monday, April 15, 2024.

Students must come in summer school uniform, neatly dressed with well-kempt hair.

The school timings from April 3, 2024 will be 7:45 am - 12:20 pm (Grades PS, PP and I) / 1:50 pm (II-XII). School buses will ply accordingly. Latecomers will not be allowed and they will be sent back.

Dispersal of non-bus students (Walkers and Van users) will begin at 12:35 pm for Grades PS, PP and I.

Grade I will disperse at 1:50 pm (Bus Users) / 2:00 pm (Non-bus) after the summer vacations.

Non-bus students (Walkers and Van users) of Grades II-VIII will be handed over to their parents/guardians/Van drivers at 2:00 pm. Please note that they will not be handed over to their elder sibling studying in Grades IX-XII.

Once again, SVIS has collaborated with Educational Initiatives (Ei) to offer Ei ASSET - a skill-based assessment that evaluates students' conceptual understanding, benchmarks the school's performance at a microscopic as well as telescopic level, and provides actionable insights through easy-to-understand reports. The test will be held in three subjects - English, Math, & Science, for Grades III to X in the first week of August. You are requested to submit an amount of **Rs. 800** to the class teacher for the same.

AQAD (A-Question-A-Day) is a set of thought provoking questions shared by the class teacher in the class WhatsApp groups (Monday-Friday) that helps our students prepare themselves for the ASSET exam as well as build their conceptual understanding.

Ei ASSET **Computational Thinking** (CT) is an optional test introduced this year for students of Grades III to X. This test is the key to preparing students for a workforce that requires dynamic individuals who are able to navigate the rapid advancements in technology and its influence on all industrial sectors. In case you would like to opt for this exam too, please submit an amount of Rs 400 in addition to the ASSET exam fee to the class teacher.

For Grades VI-X, the club option form will be shared with you as a Google Form link. **Behes, Robotics** and Astronomy clubs have been introduced as paid clubs in the new session, in addition to other clubs. Details of these clubs will be shared soon.

We expect all our students to adhere to the school rules, policies and safety protocols. Furthermore, we shall continue to equip our students with the knowledge, skills and values needed to help them succeed in further education, careers, and life beyond school.
