7. The backdrop should be presentable, preferably a plain wall or a curtain.
8. Eye contact must be maintained with the camera on your device.
9. Referring to any window on the screen, sheet of paper or prompting of any kind will not be allowed.
10. Adhere to all the rules and regulations.
