- 5. Dress Code: school uniform or formal wear.
- 6. The finalists must check the placement of the camera before the starting of the event. It should be placed in a way that does not hinder their performance in any capacity.
- 7. No referring to any screen or paper would be allowed. Any violation will result in negative marking.
- 8. The microphone and camera should be switched off till the participant is required to present.
- 9. **Judgment Criteria:** Content and Relevance to the Theme, Confidence and Body Language, Linguistic Expression (fluency, accuracy, vocabulary), Delivery (conviction, coherence, intonation), Creativity and Originality.
