3. Participants are expected to sketch the monument and explain the Law/Principle used to construct the monument.
4. Students should practice speaking in front of the camera before the final round.
5. The finalists must check the placement of the camera before the starting of the event. It should be placed in a way that does not hinder their performance in any way.
6. The backdrop should be presentable, preferably a plain wall or a curtain.
7. Referring to any screen or paper, and prompting of any kind will not be allowed.
8. The finalists will present the same monument as presented by them in the preliminary round in front of the judges and other students.
9. The finalists are requested to refer to the sequence list given above to know their turn.
