- 4. **Dress Code:** School uniform
- 5. The finalists must check the placement of the camera before the starting of the event. It should be placed in a way that does not hinder their performance in any way. The camera should be kept switched on throughout the competition.
- 6. The backdrop should be presentable, preferably a plain wall or a curtain.
- 7. The microphone should be kept switched off at all times until the name of the finalist is called.
- 8. Referring to any window on the screen, sheet of paper or prompting of any kind will not be allowed.
- 9. The finalists are requested to refer to the sequence list given above to know their turn.
