1. The final round will be held on **Wednesday, 24th November, 2021 from 4:00 pm to 5:00 pm.**

2. The finalists will be reading a story based on SDG 10 (Reduced Inequalities) or SDG 11 (Sustainable Cities and Communities). The SDG chosen should be the same as the one for the preliminary round.
3. The story review will include a self-composed synopsis, views of the students, analysis on how it relates to the selected SDG, and a comparison with the story presented in the preliminary round.
4. The finalists will **log in sharp at 3:45 pm**, so that instructions for the competition can be specified and attendance can be taken. Please log in on time.
5. Dress Code: school uniform or formal wear
6. The finalists must check the placement of the camera before the starting of the event. It should be placed in a way that does not hinder their performance in any capacity.
7. No referring to any screen or paper would be allowed. Any violation will result in negative marking.
8. The microphone should be switched off till the participant is required to present, and camera should be switched on at all times.
9. Please note the order in the list of finalists to know your turn and be prepared accordingly.

**Judgement Criteria:** Content and Relevance to the Theme, Confidence and Body Language, Linguistic Expression (fluency, accuracy, vocabulary), Delivery (conviction, coherence, intonation), Creativity and Originality.
