3. The finalists will present their video shared in the preliminary round. They will start their presentation with a **brief introduction** about the **importance of conserving the cultural heritage and the reason for choosing the particular World Heritage Site** in front of the judges and the audience.
4. Participants may dress up as tourist guides. It will be a formal event.
5. The finalists must check the placement of the camera before the starting of the event. It should be placed in a way that does not hinder their performance in any manner.

6. The backdrop should be presentable, preferably a plain wall or a curtain.
7. Do not move during the presentation and maintain your eye contact with the camera on your laptop or screen.
8. Referring to any other gadget and any form of prompting is not permitted.
9. Adhere to all rules and regulations.

Judgment Criteria: originality, content, expression, confidence, the overall appeal of the presentation.
