5. Participants may dress up as chefs or wear dresses related to the state chosen by them. If that is not available, they should wear the school uniform or any formal attire. Please do not wear night suits or lounge wear. It will be a formal event.

6. Check the placement of the camera before the commencement of the event. Your face and voice should be clear.
7. The backdrop should be presentable, preferably a plain wall or a curtain.
8. Background music or instrumental music (optional) can be used.
9. Eye contact must be maintained with the camera on your device while presenting your dish.
10. Referring to any screen, paper and prompting will not be allowed.
11. Please refer to the sequence list shared above to know your turn. Adhere to the rules and regulations and the time limit (2-3 minutes).
