**Instructions for all the shortlisted candidates:**

1. The final round will be held on **25th August 2021 from 4:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.**
2. Participants are requested to **log in sharp at 3:45 p.m.** so that the instructions for the competition can be specified and attendance may be marked. Please log in on time.
3. The finalists will present the same content as presented by them in the preliminary round in front of the judges and other students.
4. The maximum time to present the entire content, including the introduction, is 3 minutes.
5. Check the placement of the camera before the commencement of the event. Your face and voice should be clear.
6. Participants are requested to make sure that they share the screen with the audio while sharing their screen to present.
7. The backdrop should be presentable, preferably a plain wall or a curtain.
8. Students will be required to dress up as News Reporters.
9. No unnecessary movement is to be made during the speech, and eye contact must be maintained with the camera on the device.
10. Please refer to the sequence list shared above to know your turn. Adhere to the rules and regulations.

**Judgment Criteria:** voice modulation, intonation originality, creative thinking, expression, costume/props, confidence, the overall appeal of the presentation.
