Guidelines for the participants:

1. The final round will be held on **23rd August 2021 from 4:00 p.m. to 5 p.m.**
2. The finalists will speak in front of the judges and other students on the same character chosen by them for the preliminary round.
3. Participants are requested to **log in sharp at 3:45 p.m.** so that the instructions for the competition may be specified and attendance may be marked. Please log in on time.
4. Participants must wear costumes as per the demands of the character chosen by them. Props are optional.
6. Students should practice speaking in front of the camera before the final round.
7. Check the placement of the camera before the commencement of the event. The focus should be chest up so that your face and voice is clear.
8. The backdrop should be presentable and preferably a plain wall or curtain.

9. The participants should avoid any movement during the speech, and maintain eye contact with the camera of the device.
10. Referring to any window on the screen, sheet of paper or prompting of any kind will not be allowed.
11. Please refer to the sequence in the list above to know your turn. Adhere to the rules and regulations.
