8. The backdrop should be presentable, preferably a plain wall or a curtain.
9. Maintain your eye contact with the camera on your laptop or screen.
10. No referring to any screen, paper and no prompting.
11. Please refer to the sequence list shared above to know your turn. Adhere to the rules and regulations and time limit (2-3 minutes including 20 seconds for introduction).
