QUEEN'S VALLEY SCHOOL CIRCULAR FOR STUDENTS (III-XII) QUINTESSENCE (2021-22)

This is to inform all students from classes III to XII that the school's Editorial Board is inviting write-ups in the form of articles, poems, anecdotes, and illustrations for the School Magazine-QUINTESSENCE 2021-22. The theme for the same is **Sustainable Development Goals.**

Theme brief: The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) or Global Goals are a collection of seventeen intertwined global goals designed to be a framework to achieve a better and sustainable future for all. They were set up in the year 2015 by the UN General Assembly and are intended to be achieved by the year 2030. Education and awareness is a medium through which SDGs can be reached within the stipulated time period. The seventeen Sustainable Development Goals work in close integration with each other. 'No Poverty' and 'Zero Hunger' work in sync with 'Quality Education'. The goal of 'Sustainable Cities and Communities' works in close association with that of 'Industry, Innovation, and Infrastructure'.

These goals may be integrated with any subject of your choice to create a write-up. Contact the respective subject teacher for guidance. The last date of submission is **20th August 2021**.

The write-ups will be finalised by the Editorial Board based on the following criteria:

- The originality of thought and expression (Plagiarised content will be outrightly rejected.)
- Relevance to the theme
- Linguistic accuracy

Students are not allowed to send more than two write-ups/illustrations. Both submissions should be sent as separate emails. The best out of the two entries *may* be selected for publishing. Instructions to send the mail of submission for write-ups:

- 1. The submission for all subjects (except for Hindi and Sanskrit) should be done as Word doc or Docx files only. Entries in the format of PDF, JPG, or JPEG files will not be accepted.
- 2. The write-ups for Hindi and Sanskrit may be written in legible handwriting and scanned to be sent for submission.
- 3. The submissions should be named according to the convention- **Name_Class_Subject.** No entry will be entertained without a proper naming convention.
- 4. The standard protocol should be followed concerning the submission of the mail. The details are as follows:
 - A. MAIL SUBJECT LINE: School Magazine 2021-22 Submission
 - **B.** MAIL CONTENT: Name, Class, and Section, Subject for which the submission is made. (All these details should be mentioned in the document as well)
 - **C. MAIL ATTACHMENT:** the Word document with the file name as the name, class, and section of the student.
 - **D. CONTENT TYPE:** Story, poem, anecdote, jokes, musings, dialogue, personal experience, or any unique formal format about the theme. Short tales of about 10-15 words may also be submitted under the category 'Indelible Inklings.'
 - **E. WORD LIMIT:** 200 words
 - F. FONT STYLE AND SIZE: Times New Roman, 11 (for content) and 14 (for headings)

Instructions to send the mail of submission for illustrations:

- 1. The submission for illustrations should be done as JPG or JPEG files only. Entries in the format of Word Doc, Docx, or PDF files will not be accepted.
- 2. The standard protocol should be followed for submission of the mail. The details are as follows:
 - **A.** MAIL SUBJECT LINE: School Magazine 2021-22- Submission
 - **B.** MAIL CONTENT: Name, Class, and Section
 - **C. MAIL ATTACHMENT:** the JPG or JPEG file named as the name, class, and section of the student.
 - **D. CONTENT TYPE:** Abstract-painting, Comic strip, Calligraphy, Doodle, or any other relevant form on the theme.

The submissions should be scanned properly. The entry will be rejected in case of a lack of image clarity.

Please note the mail ids for submission. You are requested to send the entry to the mail address corresponding to the subjects.
