Doodles are simple drawings that can have concrete representational meaning or may just be composed of random and abstract lines, in which case it is usually called a "scribble". Students have to write any goal (as it is) , in doodle form such that it also conveys its meaning. (eg; Google doodle- where each letter of the word Google is designed describing the subject or the occasion of that day). They must be original. They must not contain content, material or any element that is inappropriate, discriminatory in any way or otherwise does not comply with the theme and spirit of the Competition.

- Participation is **MANDATORY** as students will be marked for Art Education (SEWA) on the basis of this activity.
- Submission for this competition will be done on MS Teams under Assignment section on 18th April before 5pm. Students will share two
 photographs; one while holding the work where <u>both student and work should be clearly visible</u> and other of <u>just the work</u>. Format of
 submission should be JPG only.

**Shortlisted students will participate in the final round on MS Teams for the Online competition on <u>29th April, 2021 (Thursday) from 4PM to</u> <u>5PM</u>. Link for the competition will be shared before the competition date.
