5. Check the placement of the camera before the commencement of the event. Your face and voice should be clear.
6. The backdrop should be presentable and preferably a plain wall or a curtain.
7. No unnecessary movements should be made during the explanation and eye contact must be maintained with the camera on your device.
8. Referring to any screen, paper, and prompting will not be allowed.
9. Please refer to the sequence list shared above to know your turn.
10. Adhere to the rules and regulations and the time limit, that is, maximum 2 minutes.
