
VIDYASHREE OUTREACH PROGRAM



Tobacco kills more than eight million avoidable deaths annually due to lung cancer, heart diseases, stroke as well as respiratory illnesses. Global intervention is necessary given that second-hand smoke alone takes away approximately 1.2 million lives per year.

Did you know?

Most smokers start before the age of 18, making it crucial to educate young people about the risks of tobacco.

The global economic cost of smoking is over \$1 trillion, considering healthcare expenses and lost productivity

Non-smokers exposed to second-hand smoke are also at risk, with around 1.2 million deaths annually attributed to such exposure.

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
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
