

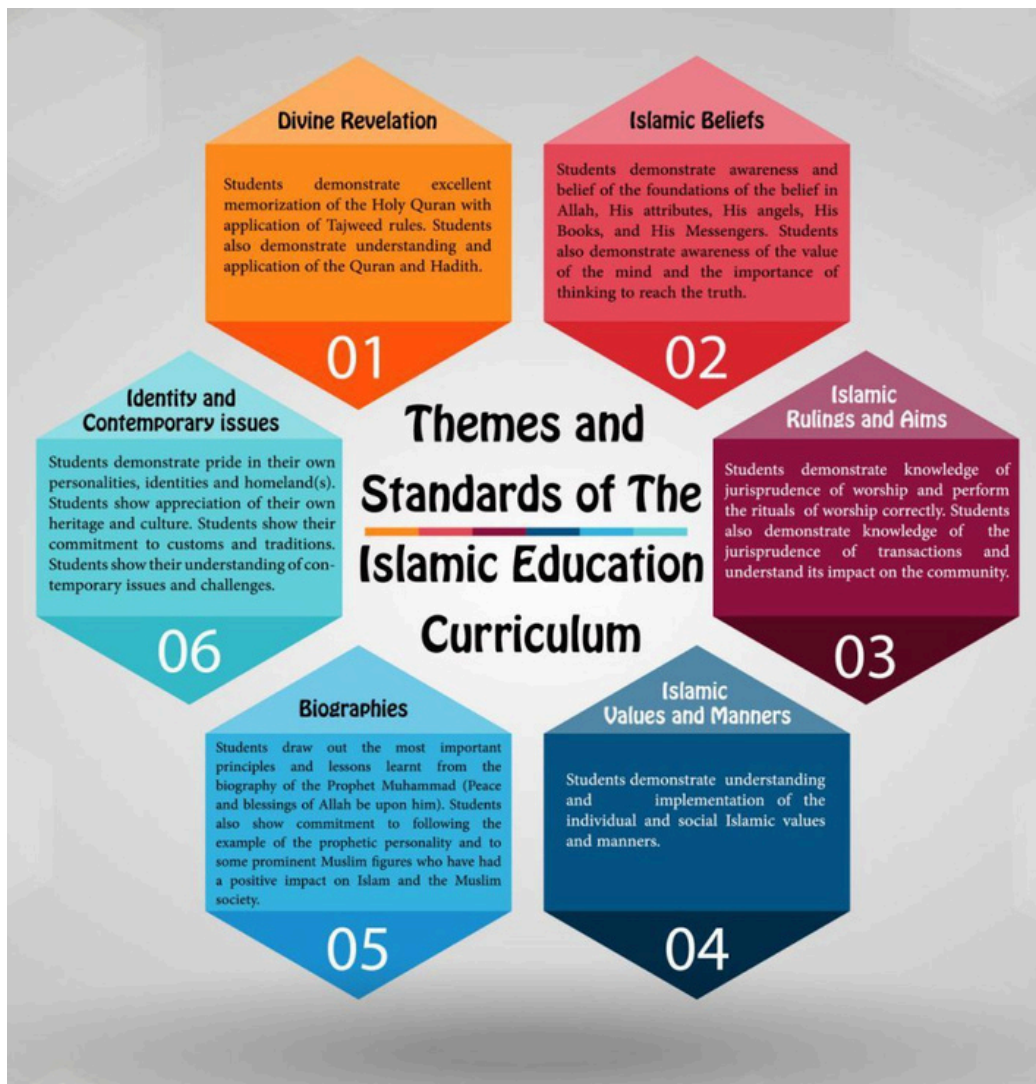

This session helped students to develop their presentation skills and to explore about the culture of UAE in Ramadan and different initiatives taken by the government in Ramadan for the service of the world.

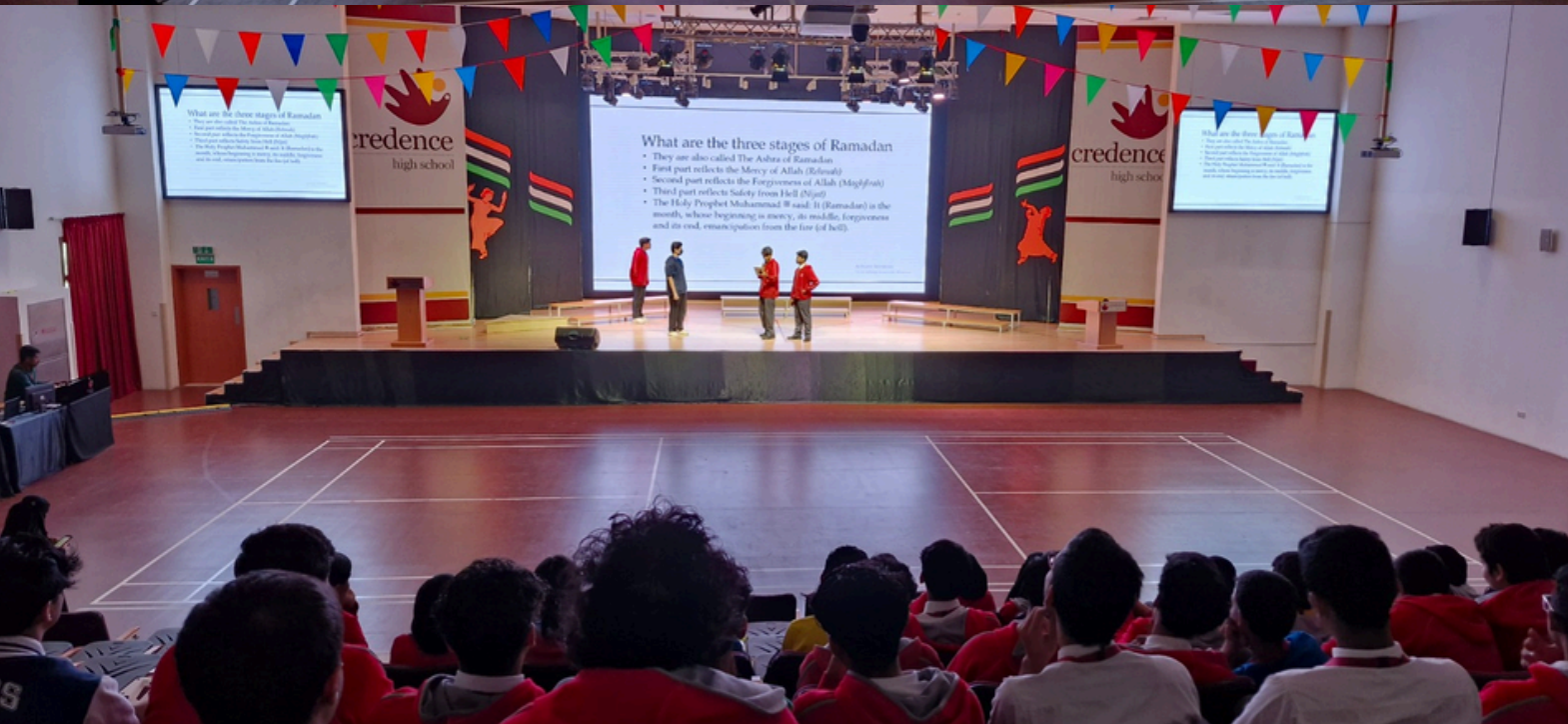
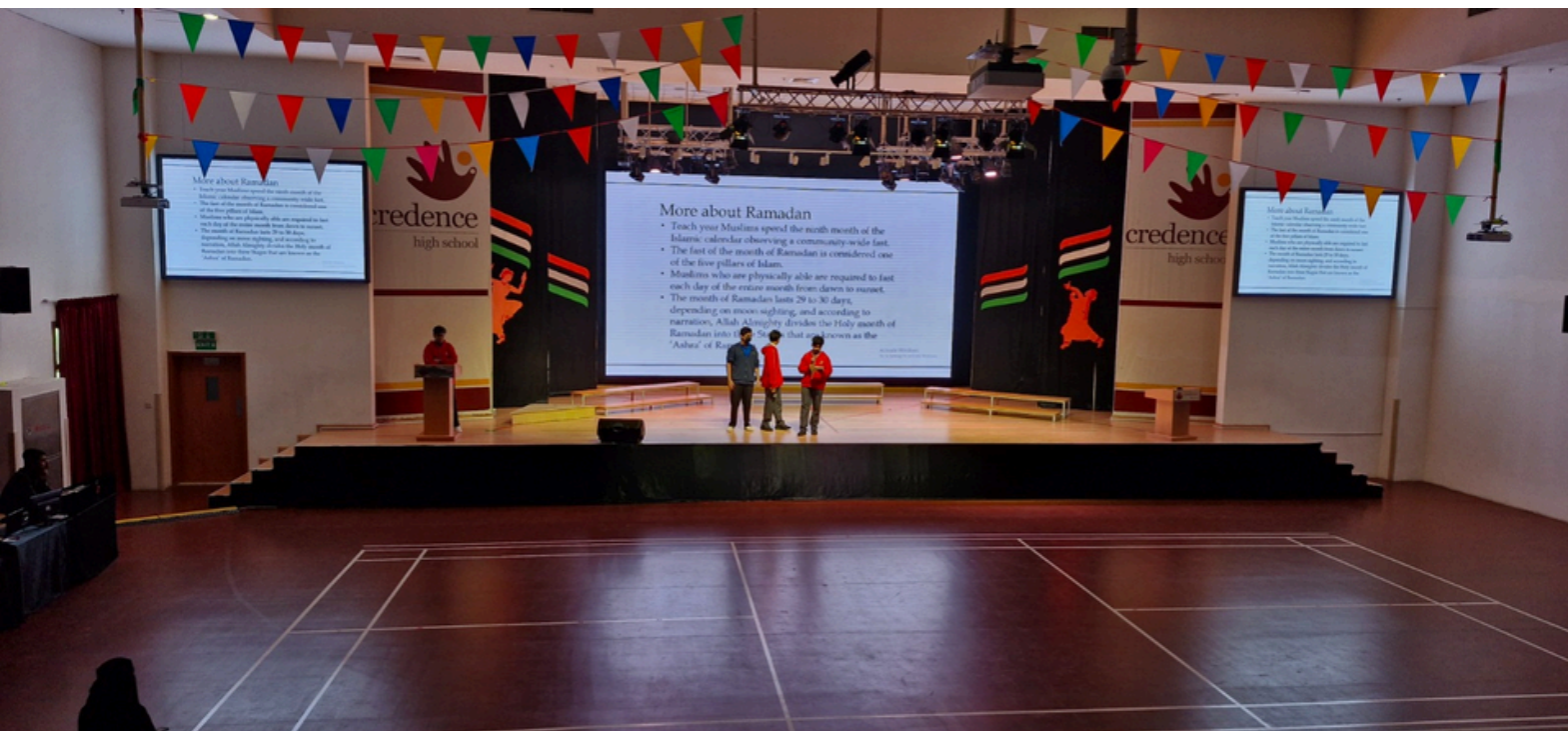
It also helped to motivate others to take the initiatives and come up with good ideas to discuss and share the information about the important events with others.

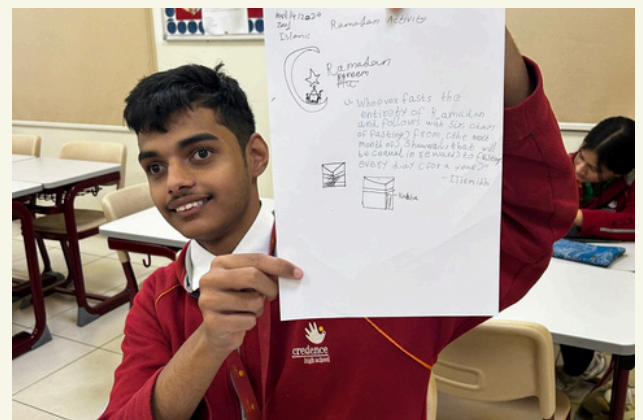
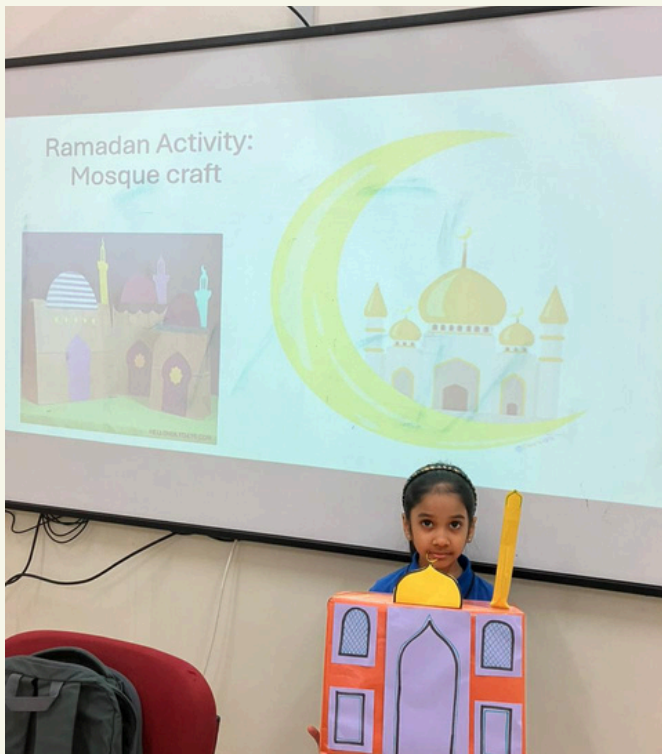




# RAMADAN ACTIVITIES

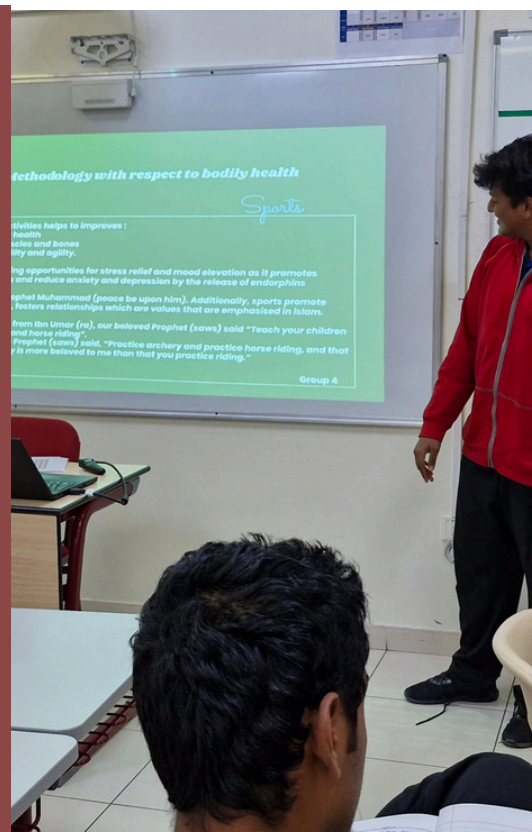
