**CIRCULAR FOR MATHEMATICS STANDARD/MATHEMATICS BASIC**

Dear Parent

CBSE has introduced two levels of assessment in mathematics in Class X: mathematics standard and mathematics basic.

Kindly note the following points w.r.t Mathematics Standard (041) and Mathematics Basic(241):

1. A student has the right to choose between the two levels of Examination - Mathematics Standard or Mathematics Basic for class X Board Examinations. The syllabus, classroom teaching, and internal assessments for both levels of examination would remain the same.
2. Students can choose according to their aptitude and ability.
3. Mathematics Standard is meant for students who wish to pursue Mathematics in their +2 level. Mathematics Basic will be for those who are not keen on pursuing Mathematics at higher levels.
4. **The school will conduct two levels of assessment only during the Pre-Board examination.**
5. Kindly note that students who would like to study Mathematics in Classes XI & XII will have to compulsorily appear for Mathematics Standard in their Board examination 2025.

Students will have to opt for the level of Mathematics they would like to appear for in the Board Examination and the same has to be submitted to CBSE on 21st September 2024. We request you to discuss with your ward her/ his choice and submit the form by Friday, 13th September 2024. **No request for a change will be entertained once you have submitted your ward's preference.**
