Description of the activity	Puppetry is a form of theatrical performance that involves the manipulation of puppets – inanimate objects, resembling human or animal figure and manipulated them by the hand movements. On 30 June 2022 a workshop was conducted by Mrs Kiran Mahajan, a teacher at ITL Public School. Teachers from Pre Primary and Primary school attended the workshop. The emphasis of the workshop was on creating different puppets and hunting for the sound effects from the objects around us. The need to integrate the puppet show with the different teaching subjects and vivid art forms was expressed with many live examples. The important steps involved in story telling using puppets to make it more relevant for the students were shared by the resource person. She also briefed about the ways to animate the story puppets with voice modulation, expression and music. A hands on learning session on using puppets was also conducted. The teachers
		acquired the strategies to incorporate puppetry story session in the classroom domain. It was a very enriching session as teachers learnt to create and recreate concept based on stories and incorporate them in their teaching.
