

Participation in the 13th Global Skills Summit at FICCI

In India, the growing unemployment among the educated youth poses a serious concern to the value of traditional education. Though the government has initiated various efforts to develop a robust vocational and skill ecosystem, a lot still needs to be done. With this objective, a **two-day Global Skills Summit** was organized by **FICCI** on the theme-: *Education to Employability- Making it happen*. The two-day Summit was organized on 27th and 28th of September, 2022.

The Summit was inaugurated by **Shri Dharmendra Pradhan**, the Hon'ble Minister of Education and Skill Development & Entrepreneurship. He released two official reports titled- *Skill Reforms; Reimaging Vocational Education in India*. The two-day Summit witnessed informed deliberations by learned panellists like **Dr. Biswajit Saha**, (Director, Skill Education. CBSE), Dr. **Nirmaljeet Singh Kalsi** (Chairman, NCVET), **Prof. Anil Sahasrabudhe** (Chairman NETF) and **40 other renowned dignitaries** from the government, vocational education and industry backgrounds.

Ms. Parineeta Sharma attended the two-day Summit as a Delegate on behalf of ITL Public School and could fruitfully participate in the Open House sessions after the panel discussions. There were several key takeaways from the session including the need for best practices that can support seamless integration of skilling in schooling and schooling in skilling.
