An enriching workshop on Physics was organized at N.K. Bagrodia Public School by the “**Sankalp Sahodaya**” Committee.

The crux of the workshop was **E Valuation** – Effective Valuation of the **Pupil’s Performance**.

“Evaluation is a process that critically examines a program. It involves collecting and analyzing information about a program’s activities, characteristics and outcomes. Its purpose is to make judgements about a program to improve its effectiveness, and/or to inform programming decisions.”  
Coined by Patton, 1987

The main emphasis was given on designing of the question paper with an aim to judge the students on the basis of understanding of concepts. The question paper should be such that all students find it challenging. The questions should cater to all types of students --- very bright, as well as the average. In this approach, the intention is not to increase the difficulty level of the question, but frame newer questions based on NCERT which can make some concept clear to the students. The resource person gave numerous examples from Physics NCERT book towards framing of such questions.

The interactive questionnaire session, at the end, gave a new edge to the session. The workshop was indeed an informative and enjoyable experience for the teaching of Physics.
