SEERAH WEEK



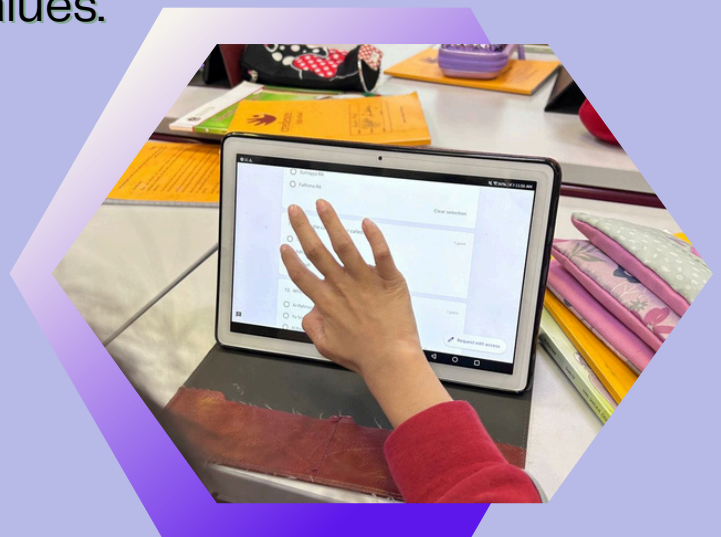

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ISLAMIC QUIZ

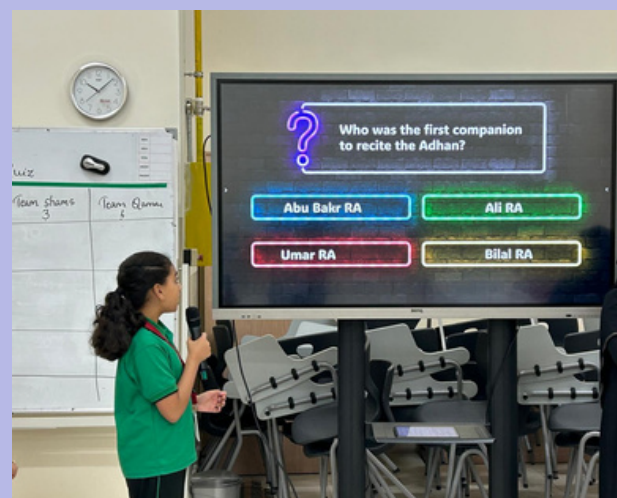
Musabaqah Al-Marifah Al-Islamiyah

TABLE TALKS

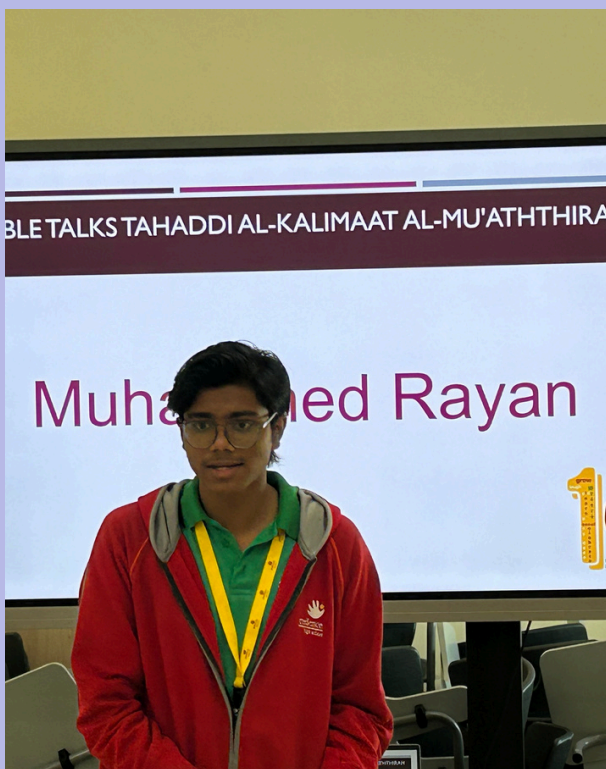
Tahaddi Al-Kalimaat Al-Mu'aththirah
