Dear Parents,

In continuation of circular No. F. No. DE.40(6)/90/SCB/2024/506-511 regarding **Tree Plantation / Greening Drive**, A special **Tree Plantation Drive is to be conducted on 9 August 2024** in the school premises. This initiative is a part of our commitment to environmental stewardship and aims to instill the values of responsibility and care for our planet in our students.

We request each student to bring **one plant** to school on the day of the event. The plant can be of any type - shade giving, fruit-bearing, or ornamental—as long as it is suitable for planting. This hands-on activity will not only contribute to our green initiative but also provide students with a meaningful experience in nurturing and caring for nature.

We encourage you to choose from the following Indigenous species that are well-adapted to our local environment or choose any other tree as per the availability:

- Nursery - Shade giving (Banyan, Neem etc)
- Kindergarten - Fruit bearing (Mulberry Tree, Jamun Tree etc)
- Class 1 - Indian Beech (Pongamia pinnata)
- Class 2 - Aloe Vera
- Class 3 - Deodar (Cedrus deodara)
- Class 4 - Peepal (Ficus religiosa)
- Class 5 - Indian Blackberry (Jamun) (Syzygium cumini)
- Class 6 - Neem (Azadirachta indica)
- Class 7 - Indian Trumpet Tree (Tabebuia rosea)
- Class 8 - Banyan Tree (Ficus Benghalensis)

Guidelines for bringing plants :-

- **Plant Preparation:** Please ensure that the plant is in a pot or container that is easy for your child to handle.
- **Labeling:** Kindly label the plant with your child's name and class.
- **Safety Measures:** Please remind your child to handle the plant with care and follow all safety guidelines.

We encourage you to discuss the importance of planting trees and caring for the environment with your child. Your support and participation in this initiative are greatly appreciated and will contribute to making this event a success.

Thank you for your cooperation and for fostering a sense of environmental responsibility in our students.
