






















They engaged in a bookmark-making activity that fused creativity and self-expression, serving as a practical aid for their reading journey.










Activity Based Learning

Moral of the story: If we help others, God will always protect us.





It was indeed a happy Earth Day celebration enjoyed by all.




























































LABOUR DAY








Fire Mock Drill


TIGER DAY


On World Tiger Day, students were embarked on a fun-filled photobooth activity, our young explorers transformed into tigers, embracing their inner roar!

With colorful paper and glue the students were involved in tearing and pasting activity to create their unique kites. Students worked together, sharing materials and ideas.



























FRIENDSHIP DAY














GANESH CHATURTHI


