	I-II	<b>Tealight Candle Decoration</b>	Students will design traditional and modern tealights. Materials will be provided in the school.
	III	<b>LED Tealight Decoration</b>	Students will engage in an eco-friendly event to create LED tealights in a safe and sustainable way. Materials will be provided in the school.
	IV	<b>Ganesha Wall Hanging</b>	Students will create decorative wall hanging featuring Lord Ganesha. Materials will be provided in the school.
