## **Specific Instructions:**

- ★ This competition is divided into two categories while Perspectives is open to the students in classes IX XII, दृष्टिकोण is meant for students in classes VI VIII.
- ❖ In the preliminary round
  - a) The participants will be required to present their views on the book. They have a freedom of choice of structure and content points. There is no specific time limit for this expression.
  - b) This will be followed by a discussion on questions pertaining to characters, themes, plot and pertinent issues in the book. The number of such questions will be three.
  - c) Adjudicators will act as active discussion moderators to encourage the participants to express their perspective on the questions displayed for discussion.
  - d) Adjudicators may discuss, cross question, seek clarifications and ask for elaboration to facilitate the decision making process.
- ❖ In the **final round**, discussions will be held with the selected participants on two different questions.
- The students will be assessed on the following parameters
  - a) relevance of content / विषयवस्तु की प्रासंगिकता
  - b) cohesion and coherence in thought / विचारों में सम्बद्धता
  - c) fluency and accuracy in expression / प्रवाहपूर्ण अभिव्यक्ति एवं सटीकता
  - d) employment of contextual vocabulary and textual references / प्रासंगिक शब्दावली और पाठय संदर्भों का उपयोग
  - e) effort at taking initiative, responding and taking the discussion forward / पहल करने, प्रतिक्रिया देने और चर्चा को आगे बढ़ाने का प्रयास
- The decision of the adjudicators will be final and binding.

Condensed and controlled, *The Namesake* covers three decades and crosses continents, all the while zooming in at very precise moments on telling detail, sensory richness, and fine nuances of character. The novel moves between events in Kolkata, Boston, and New York City, and examines the nuances involved with being caught between two conflicting

cultures with distinct religious, social, and ideological differences.



### **General Instructions:**

- The event will be held on Saturday, 24<sup>th</sup> August 2024 and Sunday, 25<sup>th</sup> August 2024.
- Confirmation of participation in the event should be intimated to the host school via email. Please send the registration sheet to <a href="mailto:info@queensvalley.in">info@queensvalley.in</a> after registering the participants using the given links.
- Spot entries are not permitted.
- The reporting time for both the days is 8:00 a.m. The participating schools are requested to send an accompanying teacher with the students on both days.
- All participants must be attired in formals or school uniform. It is mandatory to show the school I-Card at the registration desk.
- The proceedings for the event will conclude at 2:30 p.m. on 24<sup>th</sup> August 2024 and 3:00 p.m. on 25<sup>th</sup> August 2024. The participating schools are requested to make their arrangements accordingly.
- The participating school may enter teams of three members each in two categories Cubs (aged 10-13 years) and Lions (aged 14-18 years). Please note that these two age groups would be competing separately.
- The responsibility of the electronic device carried by the members of the team lies entirely with them. The host school will not take any responsibility in case of loss or damage.
- The participating schools are also advised to ensure a personal internet connection in the form of a USB dongle, even as Wi-Fi internet facility will be provided by the host school.
- The decision of the adjudicators will be final and binding.
- The payment for participation in the event should be directly made to 'Behes'.





# BEHES DWARKA ROUND AT QVS

'Behes' conducts and trains for debate in what is a simplified parliamentary format. Two teams with three speakers each face off against each other in each debate to argue a set motion. Every 'Behes' tournament is held in a knock-out format with one winning team emerging at the end of a series of challenging debates. The motions are formulated from a suggested reading list that is made available to the students before the tournament.






# BEHES DWARKA ROUND AT QVS

#### **Debate Flow:**

- ❖ The adjudicator flips the coin to decide the proposition and opposition team before announcing the motion.
- The adjudicator will announce the motion and give 15 minutes to both the teams to prepare their arguments. Participants are not allowed to use any kind of electronic device, the internet or reading material in any form for the first 8 minutes of the total preparation time. After 8 minutes, in the remaining 7 minutes, use of the internet is allowed.
- Any kind of electronic device cannot be used after the preparation time is over. However, the use of hand written notes is permitted while speaking.
- After 15 minutes, the first speaker from the proposition team (for the motion) will come forward and present their arguments. They can speak for 3-4 minutes. The adjudicator will tap once when 3 minutes are over and twice after 4 minutes. Any arguments presented beyond this time will not be considered. However, the speaker can complete their sentence after the tap.
- ❖ After a gap of 60 seconds, the first speaker from the opposition team will come forward and speak.
- ❖ In this way, speakers from each team will speak alternately with a gap of 1 minute between each speaker.
- The adjudicator will not give their feedback or announce the winner at the end of the debates on Day 1.
- \* Knock out rounds will be held on Day 2. The decision of the adjudicator will be final and binding.









**'Behes'** aims to promote effective communication, public speaking and debate through workshops, tournaments and language labs. The organisation also offers workshops at gracious host schools (usually preceding tournaments) where the trainers demonstrate how to 'Behes'.

## Why Behes?

India has been following an age-old, stagnant practice in schools with students reading out canned speeches on the topic provided prior to the debate day. 'Behes' endorses the free flow format of debating which is being followed across the globe. It is the development of collaborative, analytical, and persuasive skills apart from oratory faculties. At 'Behes', it is believed that the power to speak well comes only with the power to think well. The format of the tournament and the reading list are designed with this objective in mind.
