
















REGISTRATION PROCESS

We invite individual delegates or group of delegates as a part of a school delegation to participate in GIS MUN 4.0. Faculty advisors are also welcome to attend the conference at no extra cost. Rules and regulations:

- 1. Entry fee is ₹1500 (For Students) & ₹500 (For Teacher's Conference).
- 2. Last date for confirmation regarding the participation is 16th October, 2024.
- 3. Late entries will not be entertained.
- 4. The details of the event have been given in the brochure.
- 5. Use of slang/indecent/disrespectful/scornful language is not acceptable.
- 6. Personal remarks on a country or another delegate is not acceptable.
- 7. Participation certificates will be given to all delegates.
- 8. EB's decision will be final. Clarification regarding the judgement will not be entertained.
- 9. Allotments will be shared within two days of registration.
- 10. Fee once paid will not be refunded.
- 11. In an effort to encourage participation by school delegations, no additional costs will be levied on these schools.


