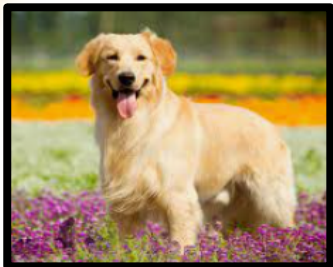

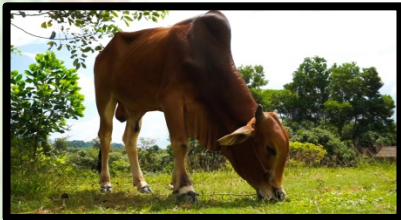
Classification - Classify animals and birds on the basis of legs:
