

Workshop: Good and Bad Touch



Grade: KG1 to Grade 1

Date: May, 2024

INTENT: It is necessary to educate young children about 'good and bad touch' for their safety and wellbeing. At Credence, we believe in incorporating these skills into their learning. Thus, our students of KG1, KG2 and Grade 1 were taught about appropriate and inappropriate touches, safe circle, and communicating fearlessly to people within their safe circle if they ever come across inappropriate touches from someone.



EXPERIENCE:

The whole concept of the session was conveyed with the help of PPT along with an animated video on good and bad touch to help them understand better. They were made aware of their private parts and that not everyone should be allowed to see or touch these parts except their parents and the doctor, in the presence of their parents. Bullying and ways to prevent bullying were also explained to them.

INSIGHT: This session helped the children understand very well how their body belongs only to them and not everyone can touch them. They are aware that they should always be alert, not letting anyone, be it family or friends touch them unnecessarily and inappropriately.
