INVESTITURE CEREMONY



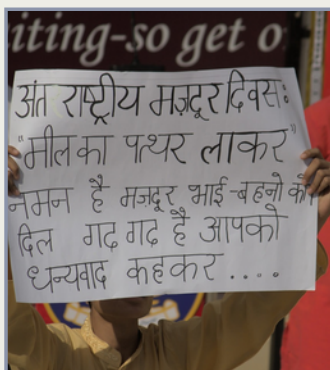

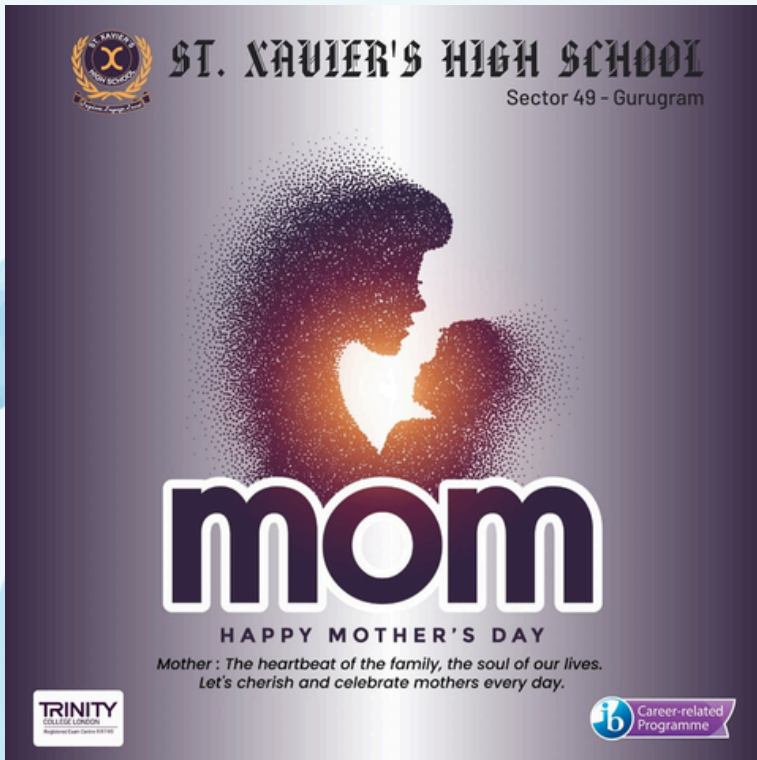
SPECIAL ASSEMBLY LABOUR DAY

MAGIC OF READING BY VIII B



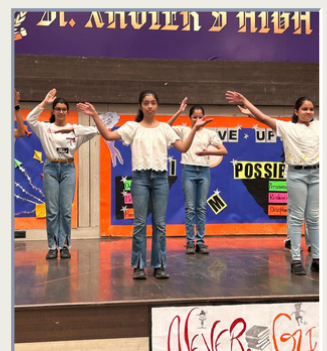
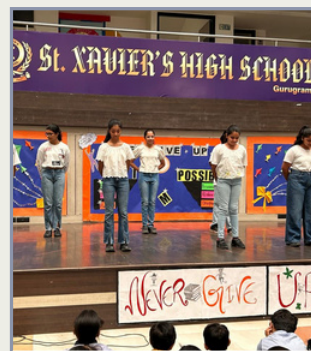

NEVER GIVE UP BY VIII C

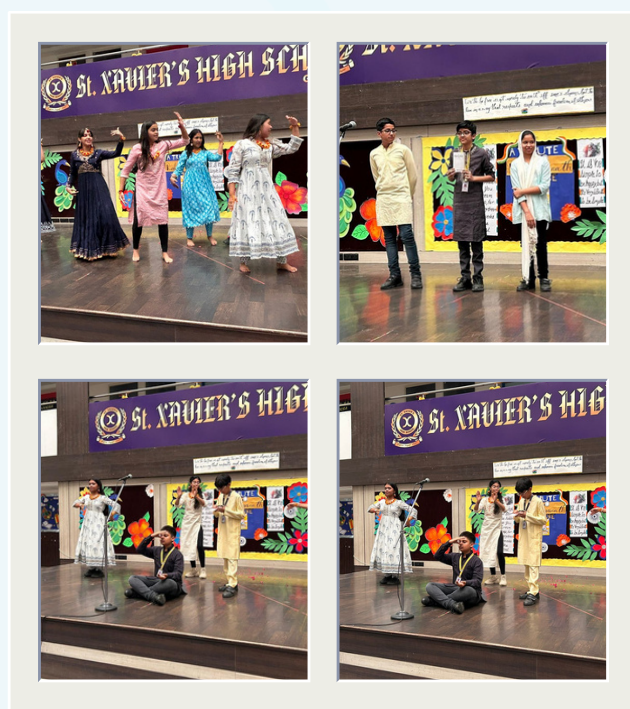
"A winner is someone who never gives up on his dreams."

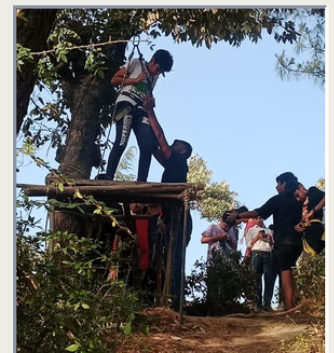
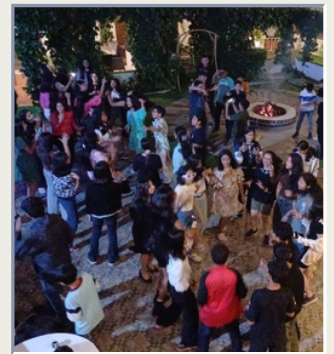
