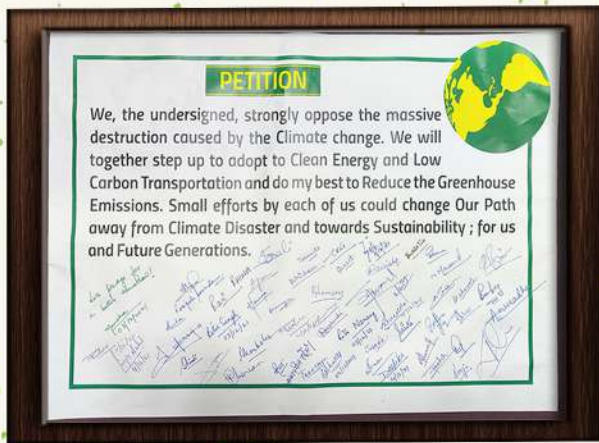




SHARE & CARE DRIVE

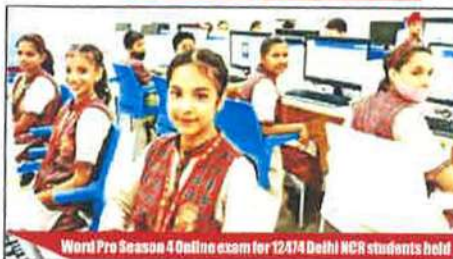
