

Qualification Criteria for Appointment of Teachers

Academic -

Basic teaching degree

PRT and TGT: At least B.A. / B.Sc. / B.Com. / B.El.Ed. /DIET for Primary Desirable - M.A. / M.Sc. / M.Com

Trained: **B.Ed**. / M.Ed. / **CTET**/ CiSELT / CiPELT/ CPD

PGT: M. A. / M. Sc./ M. Com./ MCA /BE /B. Tech./ M. Tech.

Trained: B.Ed. / M.Ed. / CTET/ CiSELT / CiPELT/ CPD

English Teachers : Preferably APTIS / IELTS or any other equivalent with Grade C as per CEFR

Teachers will be examined for their English proficiency in a school based test and also be expected to be proficient in usage of technology in classrooms.

An awareness of the latest innovations, multiple intelligence theory and Action Research based teaching is a definite desirability.

Desirable: Preferably 3 years experience in a reputed public/international school

Check details

(A) Classes I-V

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2 – year
Diploma in Elementary Education.

Or

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 45% marks and 2 – Year Diploma in Elementary Education, in accordance with the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure), Regulations 2002

Or

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4 – year Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.)

Or

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2 – year Diploma in Education (Special Education)

AND

Pass in the Teacher Ability Test (TET), to be conducted by the appropriate Government in accordance with the Guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.

(B) Classes VI – VIII

• B.A. /B.Sc. and 2 year Diploma in Elementary Education

Or

B.A. / B.Sc. with at least 50% marks and 1 year Bachelor in Education (B.Ed.)

B.A. / B.Sc. with at least 45% marks and 1 year Bachelor in Education (B.Ed.), in accordance with the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations issued from time to time in this regard.

Or

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4 – year Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.)

Or

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4 – year B.A./B.Sc.Ed. or B.A. Ed. / B.Sc. Ed.

Or

B.A./ B.Sc./ with at least 50 % marks and 1 year B.Ed. (Special Education)

AND

• Pass in the Teacher Ability Test (TET), to be conducted by the appropriate Government in accordance with the Guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.
