Suggest measures like deploying more cleaning staff and providing better waste disposal facilities.
- 3. You are Aditya Rao from Chennai, Tamil Nadu. Write a letter in about 120 words to the Traffic Police Commissioner, pointing out the problem of frequent traffic jams during peak hours. Suggest measures like creating alternate routes, improving traffic signals, and deploying more personnel to manage the situation.
- 4. You are Arvind Kumar, the head of the event management team at a cultural festival in Jaipur. Write a letter to a catering service to place an order for food and beverages for an upcoming event. Mention the number of guests, types of food, and special dietary requirements.
